On April 6, 2018, department staff met with representatives of the City of Manitowoc to discuss the status of the site investigation for the city of Manitowoc / Former Newton Gravel Pit Site ("Site") and the Wis. Stat. § 292.35 cost recovery process. This letter serves to provide a summary of the key points discussed.

With regard to Wis. Stat. § 292.11, the department has determined that the site investigation required under Wis. Admin. Code ch. NR 716 is incomplete. The Remediation and Redevelopment Program will provide a letter to the city of Manitowoc that includes further detail and direction regarding the site investigation.

With regard to the Wis. Stat. § 292.35 cost recovery process, the department is in receipt of the February 9, 2018, recommendation from Kevin Lyons, the appointed umpire for the Local Government Unit Cost Recovery Action for the Site. The department intends to hold its review of this recommendation until the site investigation is complete.
