Dear Secretary Meyer:

After reviewing your June 14, 2018 letter requiring Modification of my February 9, 2018 Recommendation, I spoke with counsel for the City of Manitowoc and with Tauren Beggs. Both described facts unknown prior to the February 9, 2018 Recommendation. Based on those facts and the facts in your letter, I revise my Recommendation as follows:

- 1. The Site investigation is incomplete. The AECOM preliminary remedial action plan, approved by the Department in a letter dated July 7, 2017, should be revised to require whatever additional investigation, interim measures, and remedial actions may be necessary for remediation of the Site.
- 2. The City of Manitowoc and all responsible parties that did not settle with the City during the Wis. Stat. § 292.35 negotiation period should pay all the costs of the additional Site investigation, revision of the remedial action plan, and all additional remedial actions, whether interim or permanent. If any pollutant discovered in this additional investigation entered the environment from non-settling responsible party, that party or parties should pay all the costs described above.
- 3. In all other respects, the Recommendation of February 9, 2018 is affirmed and incorporated by referenced in this modification.
