Tauren & Team,

Just a quick note to document scope update decisions.

1<sup>st</sup> - Thank you to the CDA & City for the ROE agreements and for the work to locate the Sherman Creek storm sewer – greatly appreciated.

Newton Pit Site:

- Water sampling of the first five existing monitoring wells was completed on Monday July 2<sup>nd</sup>. The samples have been received by the lab and we should have results in about 3 weeks.
- The new well install in the Northern Source Area should occur on Thursday – the weather looks good. Robert Weseljak will be the geologist logging the drilling. His cell phone number is 920-912-7820.
- We will schedule well development and sampling of the new well and well WT-01 after the install.

Washington Street Site:

- The two new well installs should occur on Thursday afternoon or Friday. Robert will also log the drilling.
- The following changes in scope are based on conversations with WDNR, CDA/City, and Stantec:
  - o AECOM's proposed well location, in the vicinity of Stantec's proposed well SB-37/MW-37, has been moved northward out of the PCB hot spot to the vicinity of the concrete floor/pavement edge at Stantec's proposed soil boring SB-32 (as highlighted in yellow on the attached Symbiont Figure 6).
  - o After installation and sampling, the WDNR will leave the wells in-place for future use by the CDA/City and Stantec.
  - o IDW created by AECOM's work will be left on-site for future disposal by the CDA/City in conjunction with the IDW to be generated by Stantec later this year.
  - o We will schedule the well development for the two new wells and sampling of all scheduled wells (6 total) after the install.

With these updates to the scope we are ready to go. Let me know if you have any questions.

Tauren,

Just a quick update email to memorialize a couple of phone calls from this past week.

First, I'll be on vacation next week. If you have any questions please call my cell number or give Jeff a call at 920-406-3110 or his cell at 920-698-6353.

On Monday, AECOM will be at the Newton Pit site to conduct GW sampling from five existing monitoring wells, per the scope of our contract. Tory Schultz will be the field lead, his number is 414-690-8405. The lab TAT is 3 weeks, so we should have results around the end of the month. Yesterday, we also discussed sampling well WT-01, located in the former lagoon area. Sampling of the WT-01 well is preliminarily scheduled for when we sample the newly installed well in the North Source Area (see comments below).

We have a driller scheduled for Thursday July 12<sup>th</sup> and Friday July 13<sup>th</sup> to install a well at the Newton Pit and two wells at the Washington Street sites.

I anticipate drilling at the Pit will proceed as scheduled.

Concerning drilling at the Washington Street site:

As we discussed, I am moving the proposed location of the well on the NW corner of the property. I believe we still want a new well in this vicinity to explore the impacts on GW flow from the Sherman Creek storm sewer, but the overhead powerlines in the Franklin Street

sidewalk ROW create a hazard we need to avoid. Therefore, I've moved the proposed well location on-to the property. Please see the attached figure with the new location highlighted in yellow.

I am working with the CDA/City on site access and coordinating with Stantec. If all of the coordination works out, we'll proceed as scheduled. If not, we may have to reschedule the drilling work at the Washington Street site.

I think that's it. I'll continue to keep you in the loop. Let me know if you have any questions.
