Hi Jessica,

I apologize I was sending the information to the wrong Manitowoc County Health contact. Below is what I sent to Amy Wergin in December 2019. The sampling of private wells has been expanded into the Town of Manitowoc for the Newton Gravel Pit investigation, which started in November 2019. Most of the new impacts found are along the north side of the Town of Manitowoc, primarily properties located along S. 15th and S. 19th Streets. The City was looking at doing an Open House in early March 2020, but this has been delayed at this time. It is still looking like we will have the Open House later this year. I will let you know what the scheduling for the Open House is once I get an updated date from the City of Manitowoc.

Based on your voicemail, I will let Karen Dorow and the other staff with the City of Manitowoc know you have been contacted about the sampling that has been recently done. Please call me when you get a chance so we can take care of the specific request you had from a resident.

I hope you are doing well! I am reaching out to provide you an update and to see if you want to attend another Open House for the Manitowoc/Town of Newton Gravel Pit site. Based on private well sampling results, the City of Manitowoc and their environmental consultant AECOM have expanded their private well sampling efforts into the Town of Manitowoc for chlorinate volatile organic compounds. Their expanded private well sampling started in early November and is still currently ongoing. The City and AECOM plan to have an Open House for the residents to get updates and ask any questions they may have. They are looking to schedule the Open House either the first or second Saturday in March (the 7th or 14th). I have also asked Curtis Hedman from DHS to attend. Please let me know if you want to attend the Open House, and as we get closer to March, I will provide additional details on place and time, etc.
