Concerning COVID19 Compliance Assistance.

As noted in the email string below, on Thursday March 19, 2020, the City and AECOM provided notice to the WDNR that potable well monitoring associated with the expanded sampling program would be temporarily paused for the protection of homeowners and the field sampling staff. On March 25, 2020, Governor Evers enacted the *Safer At Home* emergency order in response to COVID-19.

With Governor Evers' *Safer At Home* emergency order no longer in effect, along with the intervening time spent putting COVID19 field sampling procedures in-place, the City and AECOM are prepared to restart potable well monitoring activities.

Starting next Monday, June 1st, AECOM will be conducting PFAS groundwater sampling in accordance with the recently submitted work plan. This will be followed by conducting the normally scheduled, 5-year plan, semiannual VOC potable well sampling along with the proposed PFAS potable well sampling and continue with the expanded VOC potable well sampling program.

Tauren,

Just a quick follow-up.

As you know, the City is currently conducting a program of expanded potable well sampling for VOCs. The sampling protocol typically includes an AECOM field sampling team entering each house to conduct the sampling.

With the current situation associated with the Covid 19 virus, the City has determined that it's a good public health decision to pause sampling activities. So, as of this past Monday, March 16, 2020, we are not scheduling further sampling in an effort to protect the health of homeowners and staff.

The City is still accumulating a list of those homeowners who wish to have their water sampled. We will re-start the sampling activities once the public health professionals advise that public activities, such as our potable sampling, can recommence.
