Hi Andrea – I write on behalf of Newell Operating Company (“NOC”) to provide a further status update on negotiations between NOC and the City of Manitowoc (“City”) regarding reimbursement of a share of the City’s 2020 Newton Gravel Pit (the “Site”) related-costs.

In NOC’s March 15, 2021 update, I reported that NOC continued to await the receipt of backup documentation and work product, including Site investigation data, relating to the City’s claimed 2020 expenses. On April 13, the City provided an update as to the amount of its claimed 2020 costs. On April 14, the City and NOC had a call to discuss those costs, as well as to discuss the City’s planned 2021 Site-related work. Following that call, the City transmitted Site investigation data to NOC and its consultants at Ramboll. NOC and Ramboll are reviewing that data, as well as the recently provided updated cost information. NOC also awaits documentation relating to the City’s claimed costs for the proposed water main project.

Once NOC has received and reviewed all requested information, the City has agreed to provide NOC with a written demand for the precise amount of costs for which it seeks payment. NOC will update the WDNR on any further developments in its May 15 status report.
