All of the potable wells have been disconnected from the house's plumbing system when the houses were connected to city water. The plumbing contractor, Luisier Plumbing, has been going back and abandoning the wells when he has time in his schedule. The contractor is e-reporting the abandonment forms and keeping a hard copy to give to the city. I'm not certain... but I don't think all of the wells have been abandoned.

Once we have all of the wells abandoned – we'll provide copies of the abandonment forms.
