Supplement to the Former Kenosha Engine Plant Soil Management Plan; Request for Approval for an Additional Source of Topsoil

Dear Mr. Drews,

A Soil and Materials Management Plan (Plan) dated September 2016 was prepared for the soil remediation at the former Kenosha Engine Plant (KEP) site and submitted to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources for approval. The plan was approved on October 7, 2016 by Mr. David Volkert, the WDNR project manager. The soil remediation project is on-going and the sources of topsoil approved in the plan have been exhausted. The current remediation contractor Michels Construction, has identified a source of topsoil proposed for use at the KEP.

The proposed source of the topsoil is from the new area under construction for Foxconn located on the southwest corner of the intersection of Braun Road and County Highway H, in the Town of Somers, Racine County, Wisconsin. The site location is depicted on the attached map provided by Michels as denoted by the yellow rectangle and the topsoil stockpile is indicated by the red rectangle. AECOM has reviewed the site location by reviewing historical aerial photo graphs and the area has been agricultural since 1995, the earliest aerial photograph available on the Racine County GIS. AECOM also screened the site on the RR Sites Map for nearby BRRTS sites. A BRRTS site is located on the north side of Braun Road across from the Foxconn site. The BRRTs site was for a small farm gasoline tank that had a small release that was remediated by removal of the impacted soil and did not have any groundwater impacts. The site was given a no further action status.

Based on the site location and historical review, AECOM recommends approving this topsoil for use at the KEP as part of the temporary cap. Please provide your response by March 1, 2019. If you have any questions, please contact either of the undersigned.


WDNR BRRTS Sites within 1 mile radius
