The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) received the above "Kenosha Engine Plant Operations & Maintenance 2019" request, dated March 11, 2019 from AECOM for the former Kenosha Engine Plant (KEP) site. The funding approval request is for the DNR to approve funds for the operation and maintenance of the remaining groundwater recovery systems at the former KEP. Specific tasks include: i) perform routine monitoring and maintenance of the three groundwater recovery systems; ii) conduct routine quarterly or semi-annual monitoring and maintenance of three groundwater recovery systems; iii) recovery system sampling on a semi-annual basis; iv) preparing semi-annual reports of the influent/effluent sampling; and v) submitting the costs for vendor and utility services provided at KEP.

After reviewing and discussing the request with the DNR's Ready for Reuse Program Manager, the DNR is approving the Funding Approval Request dated March 11, 2019.
