Dear Mr. Witte:

This letter is in response to your January 12, 2005 letter to Nancy Ryan concerning the willingness of Signicast Corp., Mercury Marine and Wisconsin Precision Casting, Inc., to conduct a preliminary investigation of the Ecolab site. The Department appreciates the group's willingness to proceed with the work, without any admission of liability.

You have asked that the Department commit to identifying and notifying other parties that used Ecolab's Wax services. The Department is willing to do so, but has limited information about other customers. I have enclosed copies of information from our files that lists members of the former Ecolab PRP group and a chart (Table #1) that apparently shows an allocation of costs for the earlier work.

You have replied on behalf of three of the companies that were assigned a significant cost allocation. It is my understanding that Stainless Foundry may also be willing to participate, based on David Drays' response to Nancy Ryan. In addition, Nancy Ryan sent a letter to Waukesha Foundry, but received no response. She will send the letter again by certified mail, with a return receipt requested. Finally, the Department will send a letter to Bombardier Recreation Products in Sturtevant, indicating that the Department believes that they may have some responsibility to address the PCB contamination at the Ecolab site. Please let me know if there are other parties that you believe should be notified.

## Minutes of the May 22, 1992 ECCLAB PEF Committee Meeting

#### Attendances

The first order of business was to update the committee regarding the status of the Cermatics property. During a phone conversation with Dennis Segal of Cermatics and myself, Dennis indicated that he has purchased the property from Pete Rasmussen. Dennis also indicated that he is presently having an environmental audit conducted on the property.

A draft of the work plan for the remediation of the 10  $\times$  10 area was distributed to the PRP group for approval and recommendations. In brief the area will be excavated and the contaminated soil will be disposed of by Waste Management at their Emelle, Ala. site. The estimated cost is \$15,000. The group approved the work plan and a copy was sent to the DNR on June 2, 1992 for approval by Pan Mylotta. Pan had approved the work plan (June) and I anticipate beginning excavation the end of August.

The cost for the remediation will be pro-rated according to the participant percentage. Those PRP's that are de minimis and have not exceeded the participant percentage or \$1,000 seed money will not be assessed any additional costs. Ron Bird indicated that he has a spread sheet (table #1) on the participants percentage and the pro-rating. He incorporated the \$1,000 seed money into the spread sheet to give a total amount paid per participant. Walter Lutz indicated that their accounting department paid an extra \$1,000 (seed money) which will be subtracted from their final remedial cost (table #2).

According to Ron Bird's spread sheet there are six (6) major contributors listed (table #2). Each contributor was assessed a participant percentage and remediation cost. Checks for your cost should be sent to Don Gagas at OMC 190 Sea Horse Dr., Waukegan, IL. 60085.

Only the PRF's that contributed \$1,000 seed money (excluding Pete Rasmussen) will receive a copy of the release letter from the DNR. Neither Wisconsin Investment Cast or Volrath Co. will receive a release until their fee to CBC is paid. For the companies who sent in seed money (\$1,000), release letters will be sent to their addresses which were found on the original letter of agreement to participate dated, April 25, 1989. Those companies and addresses are listed on the last two (2) pages of the committee minutes. If there are any changes please contact me at 708/689-5228.
