Thank you for your response to my letter regarding your open spill case. Your letter requested that I confirm that the following case has been giving final closure status by the Department of Natural Resources. The department did receive the deed document and well abandonment documents I asked for in my letter of June 21, 1999. I confirm that the following case is closed:

Run the samples for VOCs, SVOCs, and RCRA metals. If this work confirms that the soil is clean, I can close the case. The former spill location should be easy to locate with the map I have enclosed. I am also enclosing a copy of the entire spill site investigation report from your old consultant, as well as some documentation indicating that contaminated soil from the spill was being considered for landfill disposal.


