A. Current Activities

On September 12, 2011, Beazer submitted a Construction Documentation Report for the completed onproperty corrective measures. WDNR issued a conditional approval of the report on October 21, 2011, but withheld final approval pending Beazer's submittal of an acceptable continuing obligations/GIS Registry package. A Notification of Continuing Obligations and Residual Contamination was submitted to the current property owner on June 16, 2014. A GIS Registry package was submitted to WDNR on August 5, 2015. Final WDNR approval of the on-property corrective measures is pending.

On May 5, 2021, WDNR issued a letter to Beazer regarding close-out of the hazardous waste compliance assessment. On November 1, 2021, Beazer submitted responses to WDNR's May 5, 2021 hazardous waste compliance assessment letter, along with a Long-Term Care License Renewal Application. On May 10, 2022, WDNR provided comments on Beazer's November 1, 2021 Long-Term Care License Renewal Application. On October 10, 2022 Beazer submitted responses to WDNR's May 10, 2022 comments, along with a revised Long-Term Care License Renewal Application. On May 1, 2023, WDNR submitted a letter to Beazer providing comments on and requesting additional information pertaining to Beazer's October 10, 2022 submittal. On July 31, 2023, Beazer submitted a response to WDNR's May 1, 2023 letter. On December 15, 2023, WDNR submitted a letter to Beazer providing a draft conditional approval of Beazer's Long-Term Care License Renewal Application. On February 15, 2024, Beazer provided comments on WDNR's December 15 draft conditional approval of Beazer's Long-Term Care License Renewal Application. WDNR provided responses to Beazer's comments on April 12, 2024. On June 28, 2024, Beazer provided comments on WDNR's April 12. responses to Beazer's February 15 comments. On October 10, 2024, WDNR submitted to Beazer a preliminary determination to conditionally approve Beazer's Long-Term Care License Renewal Application, and a memorandum dated October 9, 2024 providing responses to Beazer's June 28, 2024 comment letter. On October 11, 2024, WDNR issued a Public Notice regarding the Long-Term Care License Renewal Preliminary Determination.

FTS completed the second semiannual groundwater monitoring event in October 2024.

Beazer and USEPA continued to work on the Great Lakes Legacy Act (GLLA) Focused Feasibility Study (FFS) project for the off-property portion of the Site during this reporting period. GLLA project-related activities conducted during this reporting period included revising the hydrologic and hydraulic (H&H) modeling for Sub-Area A to address WDNR comments/requests received via email on July 15, 2024, 2024 Data Gap Investigation (DGI) data review/validation and preparation of a draft data summary report, preparation of a railroad drainage ditch investigation work plan, continued preparation of a draft Sub-Area A FFS, and participating in project team conference calls with WDNR on September 13 and October 18, 2024.
