Re: Monthly Status Update – April 2017 Penta Wood Products Superfund Site Siren, Wisconsin

GHD Services Inc. (GHD) has prepared this monthly status update for the period of April 2017 for the Penta Wood Products Superfund Site (Site). The project budget and costs are summarized in the following Tables 1 through 4. All problems, resolutions, and/or recommended solutions with an assessment of data collected during this period will be provided in the next Quarterly Report – April through June 2017. The following is a brief summary of the work completed.

Phase 02-Tasks 01 through 23

- On April 7, 2017, ferric sulfate (approximately 2,759 gallons) was removed from the Site and transported to the Envirite of Illinois facility in Harvey, Illinois for disposal as a hazardous waste.

 existing pentachlorophenol and/or arsenic concentrations at selected areas and to confirm the
 horizontal and vertical extent of contamination associated with continuing obligations at the site.
- Laboratory subcontractor costs for analyzing the soil samples will be included with a future invoice.
- Subcontractor costs for drilling and soil sampling will be included with a future invoice.

Phase 04-Task 01 Site safety plan

No costs were billed to this task in the current invoice.

Phase 04-Task 02 Site QA/QC plan

No costs were billed to this task in the current invoice.

Phase 04-Task 03 Housekeeping and grounds keeping

- The annual fire extinguisher inspections for the building were completed April 6, 2017. No costs were billed to this task in the current invoice.
- The current invoice includes subcontractor costs (Northland Fire & Safety) for inspecting the fire extinguishers.

Phase 04-Task 04 Quarterly fluid level monitoring

- The April 2017 quarterly fluid level monitoring event was completed on April 17, 2017 and data was evaluated.
- The top of casing elevation at well MW14 was re-surveyed due previous well repairs and modifications.

Phase 04-Task 05 Semiannual monitoring well sampling

- The April 2017 semiannual monitoring well sampling event was conducted on April 18 through 24, 2017 and data was evaluated.
- The current invoice includes subcontractor costs (Field Environmental Instruments, Inc.) for rental of groundwater monitoring and sampling equipment.
- Laboratory subcontractor costs for the groundwater samples will be included with a future invoice.



Phase 04-Task 06 Semiannual residential well sampling

- Letters dated April 5, 2017 were submitted to the property owners providing notification and the schedule for residential well sampling work.
- The April 2017 semiannual residential well sampling event was conducted on April 17 through 19, 2017 and data was evaluated.
- Laboratory subcontractor costs for the residential well samples will be included with a future invoice.

Phase 04-Task 07 Semiannual reporting

- The Quarterly Progress Report January through March 2017 was submitted on May 3, 2017.
- Portions of the Quarterly Progress Report April through June 2017 were prepared.

Phase 04-Task 08 Monthly reporting

- Periodic project updates were provided to WDNR.
- The project budget was updated.
- The Monthly Status Report March 2017 was prepared and subsequently submitted on April 28, 2017.

Phase 04-Task 09 Regulatory communications

No costs were billed to this task in the current invoice.

Phase 04-Task 10 Shallow soil and sediment investigation data evaluation

No costs were billed to this task in the current invoice.

Phase 04-Task 11 Soil sampling under surface debris

- On April 27 and 28, 2017, soil sampling was conducted under surface debris to assess the groundwater protection pathway due to the detected contaminant concentrations in the debris.
