Re: American Toy Company

This letter confirms our July 27, 1989 telephone conversation regarding the request to remove American Toy Company from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources 1988 Abandoned and Active Landfill Listing (see attached). As discussed, the property is an active manufacturing operation which supposedly had a liquid spill on the property. According to November 1980 documentation received from the Hortonville Manufacturing Division of American Toy and Furniture (see attached), a soil analysis was performed to ensure the property is clean. The results from Badger Laboratories show that only water and soil were present.


I also enclose copies of the report of a preliminary assessment performed at the site July 17, 1984 and the preliminary assessment summary. Based upon the information presented in these documents, this property was inadvertently added to the abandoned landfill listing. I believe that after reviewing the enclosed documents, you will agree with our conclusion. I would appreciate receiving a letter from you to serve as documentation to that effect.

I also talked to William Messinger at U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region V, as you recommended, about the possibility of removing Hortonville Manufacturing Company from the CERCLIS Listing. Mr. Messinger will be sending documentation about the procedures to be followed once a name has been added to that listing and the difficulty of being removed.

Dear Mr. Chizek:

You will recall on August 26, 1980 we were involved in removing a liquid substance and surface soil from a ditch near our property. Your concern being this could be hazardous material and construed as an illegal spill.

We sent samples of the liquid substance and surface soil to Badger Laboratories in Appleton for analysis. A photo copy determining the final analysis of the two samples were submitted to you upon your request. A few weeks later I placed a phone call to you regarding disposal of this material. You informed me it was now out of your jurisdiction and a written report would have to come from Mr. Doug Rossburg, Green Bay DNR Office.

Since November 4, 1980, I have placed five phone calls to Mr. Rossburg and have yet to talk to him. Each time I leave my name and phone number for him to return my call, yet he has failed to do this. To this date we have never received any written documentation of any kind from the DNR regarding disposal of this substance. Since it has been almost three months since the DNR has received a written report of the substance and failed to contact us regarding disposal, I therefore feel the DNR does not consider this to be hazardous waste and we can dispose of this substance. If we do not receive written instructions in the very near future, we will properly dispose of this material.



A microscopic examination showed the ash to be light brown colored, small diameter particles. The ash was moderately soluble in 1 + 1 HCl. A strong qualitative aluminum test was noted on the resulting solution.

It is our opinion that the sample is water containing small diameter soil particles. The soil is predominantly clay. No evidence of paint or caustic was observed.

The soil sample was examined in a similar fashion. No evidence of paint or caustic was observed.

Area Description: Hortonville Mfg. Co. Inc. is one of the leading industries in the Town of Hortonville, which is a small community lying in an agricultural area.

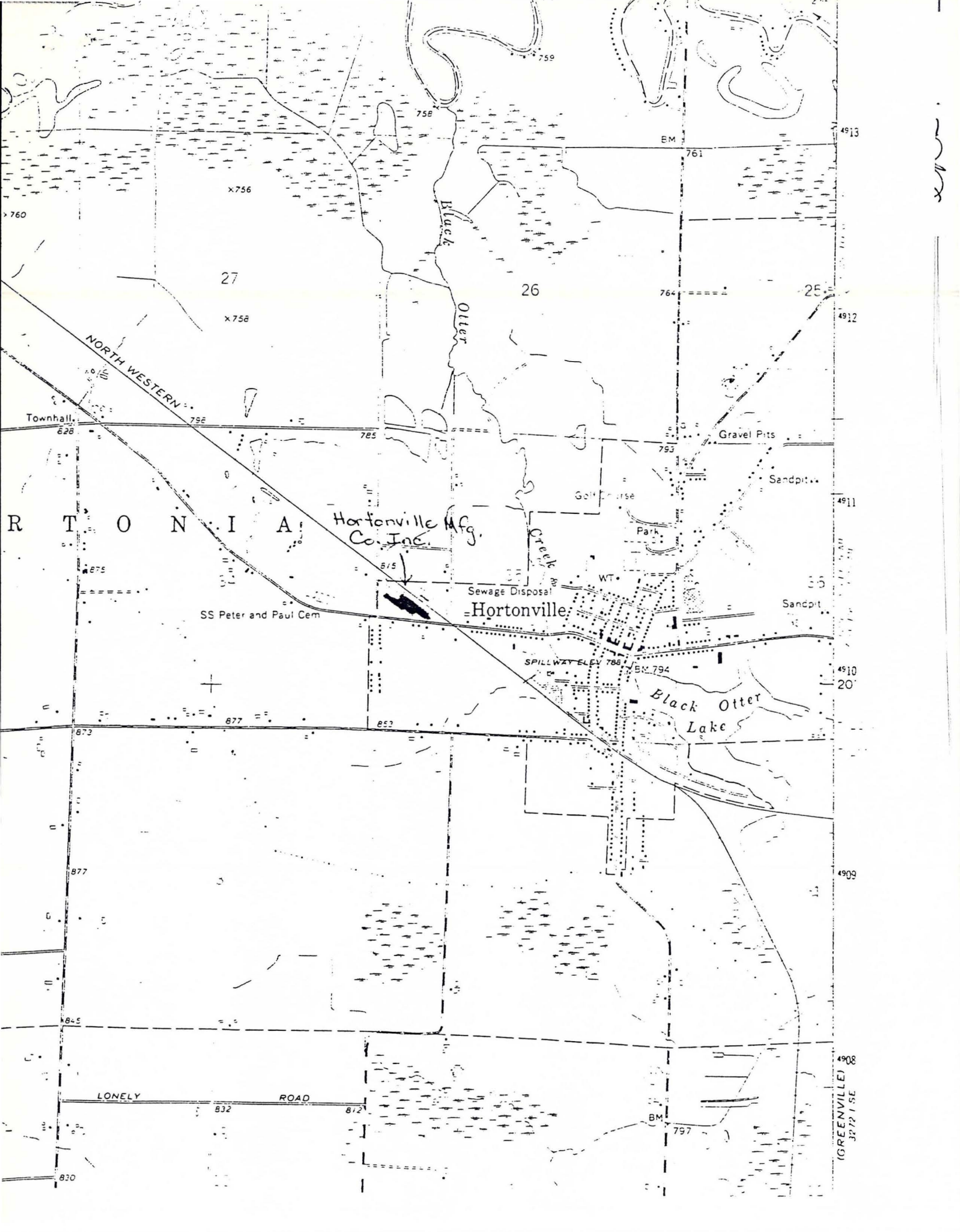
