Subject: Landfill Cost-Share Reimbursement - Lime Kiln Landfill

Dear Mr. Hofland:

We have partially approved the July 24, 2001 request for reimbursement for remediation-related activities completed at the Lime Kiln Landfill from April 1, 2000 to July 19, 2001. The total amount available for reimbursement was \$76,000.00. We have approved the payment of \$67,875.00 at this time. We are temporarily holding back \$8,125.00 due to concerns that John Feeney has about the construction of well P7B. It is possible that this well will need to be re-constructed or a new well drilled in its place.

Please contact John at 414-263-8365 to resolve the well P7B issues. Once a decision has been made as to whether or not the Village needs to do additional work related to this well we can decide when the final reimbursement can be made. If the decision is that no additional work is necessary for this well I can make the final reimbursement. If work still needs to be done I will make the final reimbursement after John approves the work.
