Follow-up investigation January 13, 1981

by a Mr. Ken Sanders from 1959 - 1961.

Property was purchased by Robert Adams
(414) 284-9846 approx Ten years ago from Ken
Sanders. Mr. Adams knows nothing about any
drums being buried on the property. Five years
ago he did some excavation while putting in
a metal roof building & found no buried drums.
Excavation ceased by asking a trench cut in
a hillside. He removed & put a pile on the
deep end & 3 on shallow end.

Upon repositing the site & drums appear 15
drums containing their end of the pipe waste,
~~either~~ drums with vapors & fumes. There were
located on edge of a 13 acre property owned
by Mr. Adams. There was a lot of ground
being poured that could be checked
with drums

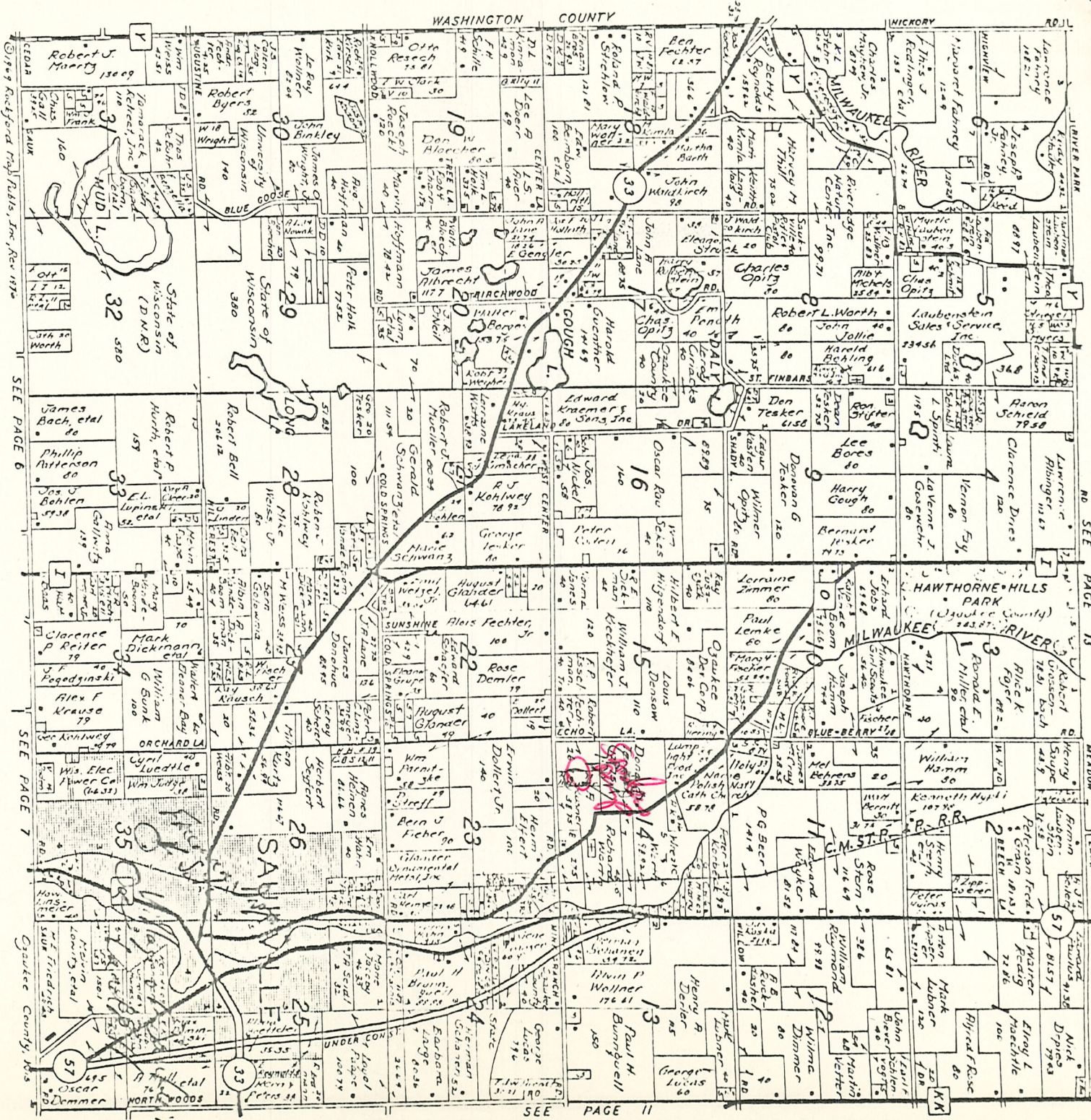

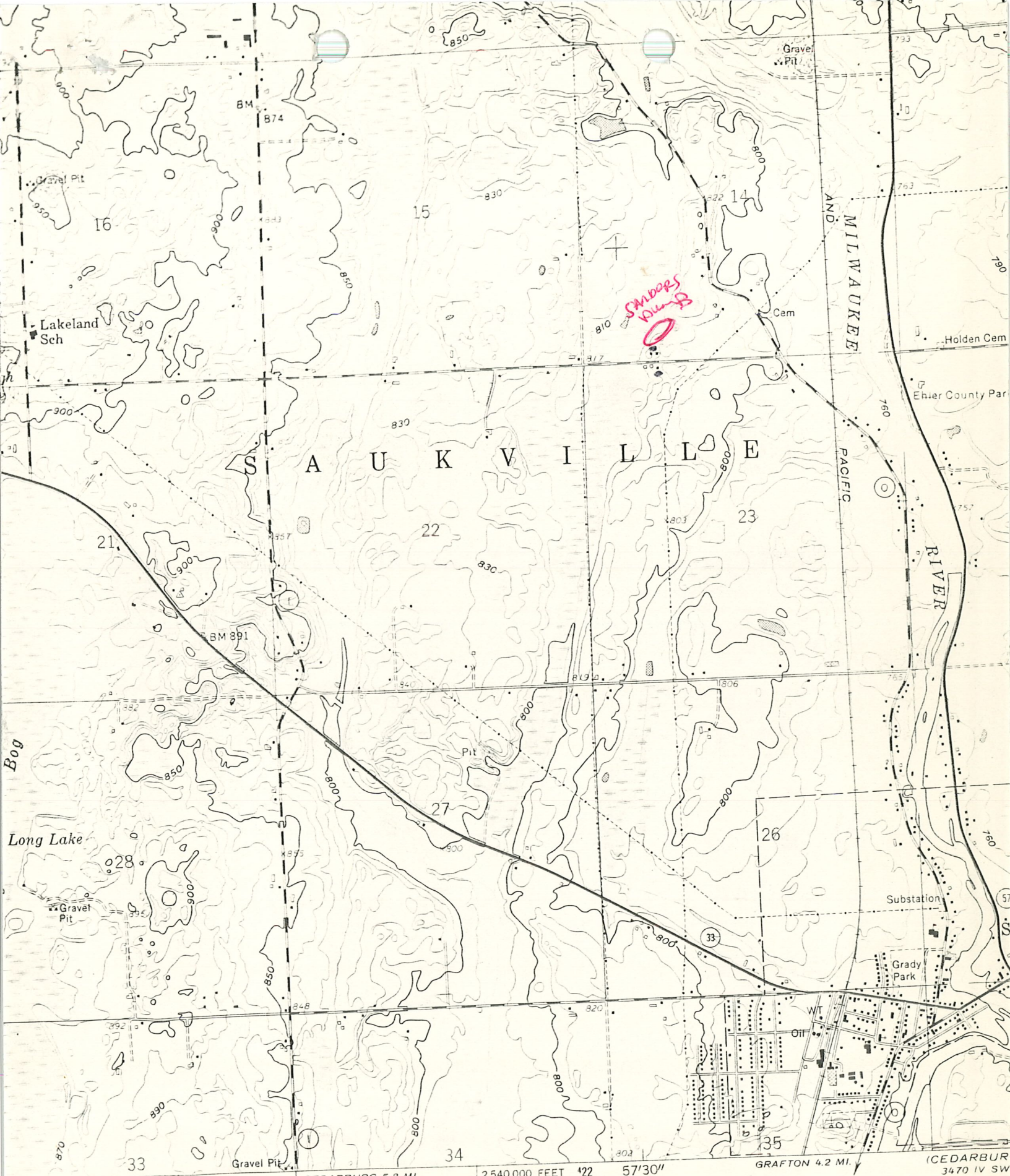

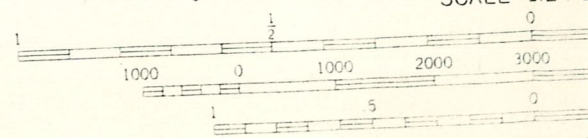
