Based on conversation with Duane Schuettpelz and yourself, we recommend chronic toxicity testing of the Freeman Chemical outfall and Village of Saukville outfall. Duane has designated Bob Masnado of his section to work with you on the bioassay design details.

We also considered bioaccumulation testing and testing of fish tissue for tainted taste; but we decided not to recommend these tests at this time.

Should we pull the general permit at this time? We believe that the general permit was violated based upon odor that interfered with the public's rights (NR102.02,1,c). However, since we are no longer receiving odor complaints downstream, we recommend that they be allowed to continue discharging while the toxicity testing takes place. If we have another odor incident or perceive toxicity, than we should order them to cease their discharge.
