Town of Port Washington Dump Site

Dear Roger:

As you know, Freeman Chemical Corporation has conducted cleanup activities at the Town of Port Washington Dump Site in the past. During late July, Freeman summer personnel conducted another "cosmetic" investigation and cleanup of the area. Throughout two work days, nine drums and one pail, all having no identifiable markings, were removed and then returned to the Saukville Plant for disposal. These were the only drums viewed by Freeman personnel, and they represented those which you and I viewed embedded in the hillside when we visited the dump site last fall.

No water samples were taken this year as all past analyses indicated that all constituents analyzed for volatile organics were well below the detection limits or entirely non-detectable, as reported in ppb or ug/l.

Freeman believes it has handled the aesthetic cleanup which you suggested it complete at the Town of Port site, and it again believes that it has demonstrated a cooperative spirit in addressing the drum removal.
