RE: Former Freeman Chemical Corporation Dump Site, SW4, Section 4, T11N, R22E, Town of Port Washington, Ozaukee County (Didier Property)

Thank you for your September 18, letter concerning the drum clean-up at the Town of Port Washington dump site.

The Department of Natural Resources is pleased that Freeman Chemical has voluntarily removed drums from the site in addition to the Town of Wayne and Town of Sherman disposal sites.

Our records indicate that Freeman Chemical also used the Saunders property in the Town of Saukville (1806 W. Center Road) for drum disposal in the past. Mr. Russell Cerk inspected the property in December, 1986. At that time a few drums were seen. Do you plan any further removal activities at this or any other disposal site not previously cleaned up? If you feel that all past disposal sites have been cleaned up please let me know in writing so that we may close out this matter.

Again, the Department thanks Freeman Chemical for its efforts to redress past disposal practices.
