> RE: Work Plan Due Date Extension Additional Work

Dear Mr. Bostwick:

Pursuant to your request dated September 3, 1992, and your request during the U.S. EPA/WDNR/CCP meeting held on September 9, 1992, a ninety (90) day extension is granted for the work plan required pursuant to U.S. EPA's letter to CCP dated July 24, 1992. The 90 day extension begins on September 12, 1992, the original due date of the work plan. The new due date is December 11, 1992.

As stipulated in the meeting, the work plan shall include, but not be limited to, the three major "hot spots" (i.e. the "tank farm" area, the "old dry well" area, and the present incinerator area). A letter shall precede the work plan which will include, but not be limited to, justifications for not addressing the remaining sixteen units in the additional work plan. U.S. EPA will review this information to enable a decision on appropriateness of action at this time.

This letter are not meant to be encompass all topics or tentative agreements made at the meeting, but it addresses some major points that are necessary at this time.
