# HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY CERTIFICATE OF LIABILITY INSURANCE

COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY INSURANCE COMPANY, (the "Insurer"), of 70 Pine Street, New York, NY 10270 hereby certifies that it has issued liability insurance covering bodily injury and property damage to Cook Composites and Polymers, (the "insured"), of 340 Railroad Street, Saukville, WI 53080 in connection with the insured's obligation to demonstrate financial responsibility under s. NR 685.08, Wis. Adm. Code. The coverage applies at:



for sudden and non sudden accidental occurrences. The limits of liability are \$2,000,000 for each occurrence and annual aggregate limits of \$4,000,000, exclusive of legal defense costs. The coverage is provided under policy number PLL 5290751, issued on September 15, 1992. The effective date of said policy is September 15, 1992.

2. The Insurer further certifies the following with respect to the insurance described above:

- (a) Bankruptcy or insolvency of the insured may not relieve the Insurer of its obligations under the policy.
- (b) The Insurer is liable for the payment of amounts within any deductible applicable to the policy, with a right of reimbursement by the insured for any such payment made by the Insurer. The provision does not apply with respect to that amount of any deductible for which coverage is demonstrate as specified in s. NR 685.08 (S), Wis. Adm. Code.
- (c) Whenever requested by the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) the Insurer agrees to furnish to the DNR a signed duplicate original of the policy and all endorsements.
- (d) Cancellation of the insurance, whether by the Insurer or the insured, a parent corporation providing insurance coverage for its subsidiary, or by a firm having an insurable interest in and obtaining liability insurance on behalf of the owner or operator of the hazardous waste management facility, shall be effective only upon written notice and only after the expiration of (60) days after a copy of the written notice is received by the DNR.
- (e) Any other termination of the insurance shall be effective only upon written notice and only after the expiration of thirty (30) days after a copy of such written notice is received by the DNR.

I hereby certify that the wording of this instrument is identical to the wording specified in s. NR 685.08 (7). Wis. Adm. Code, as the regulation was constituted on the date first above written, and that the agent or broker is licensed as a surplus lines insurance agent or broker.
