This is just a short note to thank you and Mark Gordon for taking time out to meet with Carol Geiger and myself on December 8, 1995 to discuss the Cook Composites site in Saukville, Wisconsin.

As we discussed, Georgia Gulf intends to take the lead with respect to the soil remediation at the Church Yard and Logeman properties. Georgia Gulf's consultant, RMT, Inc., is in the process of preparing remedial plans for these areas consistent with the requirements with NR 700 et seq. Wis. Admin. Code. Our initial thoughts are that some active soil remediation will be required at the Church Yard site, but that activities at the Logeman property will be primarily limited to the removal of the existing solid waste. We plan on submitting the plans to the Department in early March, 1996. The mutual agreeable remedial plans would then be incorporated into an administrative consent order issued pursuant to 144.76 Wis. Stats.

Again, we appreciate your cooperation and look forward to working with you on this project.
