Dear Mr. Bostwick:

The Department received your February 12, 1996 submittal which contained revised corrective action cost estimates for Cook Composites & Polymers Co.'s (CCP) hazardous waste facility located at 340 Railroad Street in Saukville, Wisconsin. The cost estimates were submitted in response to the Department's February 1, 1996 letter which requested additional detail on costs associated with consulting engineering services, and also requested costs be included to cover CCP's ground-water monitoring program.

We have completed a review of the revised cost estimates, and have determined that they adequately address the issues discussed in our February 1, 1996 letter, and are acceptable corrective action cost estimates. CCP has previously stated that it plans to use the net worth method to establish proof of financial responsibility for these corrective action costs. Since the cost estimates have now been approved, please submit the net worth test to me within 60 days of the date of this letter. The net worth test must meet the requirements of s. 144.443(4), Wis. Stats.

On January 23, 1996, the Department also received a Hazardous Waste Facility Certificate of Liability Insurance for CCP's Saukville facility. We have reviewed the certificate and determined that it meets the requirements of s. NR 685.08, Wis. Adm. Code. It is acceptable as proof of financial responsibility for liability coverage.
