Thanks for submitting a proposal. I give approval, but please address the following concerns and requirements that I have in your pilot test report:

- Determine if the BIOX injections will mobilize other contaminants present in the soil such as the phenols, or the chlorinated volatile present in the soil at the tank farm area (up to 10,000 ppb), and former dry well area (at low concentrations).
- How long has it been since well W37 has had free product?
- Please submit a list of what downgradient wells and piezometers (or proposed ones) will be used to monitor the effectiveness of the injection in each area of concern. You may wait and include this item with your remedial action proposal.
