John,

I have received your letter dated June 12, 2019, requesting that we submit a Site Investigation Work Plan that includes an assessment of PFAS. Reportedly, this new requirement is based on the agency's review of Arkema's response to EPA's 2010/2015 PFOA Stewardship Program. Please be advised that PFAS compounds we never used, manufactured, or otherwise handled at the Saukville facility. These compounds were used at Arkema's Calvert City, KY plant which is part of Arkema's Fluorochemicals Division. This Division manufactures fluorochemicals (refrigerants) and fluoropolymers (plastics) and is completely separate from the Cook Composites product line which is not based on fluorochemical chemistry.

Based on the above, we respectfully submit that a PFAS investigation is not warranted for the Saukville facility. We look forward to receiving your concurrence. If you have any questions, please call me or send me an email and I will be happy to discuss further.
