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Linda/ Joe:

We have the vapor screening activities scheduled for tomorrow at both the Milwaukee Plating and 1422 buildings. As we discussed, the focus of the field screening perform a comprehensive field screening assessment of both buildings at the same time to try to identify the potential source of vapors previously detected in the alley and 1422 building in a timely manner. If the field screening results indicate a source controlled by Milwaukee Plating, potential mitigation could be implemented with follow-up confirmatory laboratory samples.

Once this sampling is completed and data is compiled and reviewed, we will develop a plan to move forward and submit it to the WDNR. The plan moving forward will be dependent on the results of the field screening and previous sampling. As we discussed confirmatory laboratory sampling will need to be part of this plan.

GZA has not been in the 1422 building but is prepared to field screen features in the basement that may be a potential migration pathway for subsurface vapors. In addition, we will also inspect the building for potential routes of entry that could exist above ground.

I trust that this information is helpful but if you have other questions, please let Jim or me know.
