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Michele and Linda:

This email is to provide you a status update on the remedial activities planned and in process to address the alleged non-compliance at Milwaukee Plating Company (“MPC”), specifically the TCE vapor impacts to the neighboring property to the south located as 1422 Vel R. Phillips Ave, Milwaukee, Wi.

As I stated to Linda a few weeks ago, we have been working with MPC’s historical general liability insurance carrier(s) to provide coverage for some of the ongoing and future remedial costs. This effort is coming together, and we have submitted some historical costs and a plan for future remedial activities to accomplish NR 726 case closure, i.e. future costs to address this issue and achieve NR 726 Case Closure. We are currently planning on remedial activities to address the offsite vapor migration. Joe Liello/TRC is currently working with the plant staff regarding the proposed NR 708 Immediate Action addressing the building venting system that is directed into the alley south of the MPC facility. We will have a more defined work plan for your review in the next couple of weeks or less and Kevin Hedinger/GZA and James Drought/GZA are working on the NR 726 Case Closure for the facility.

Please note that Al (Alford H.) Mattacotti is deceased as recently, I believed, as Sunday, 5-26-2024. The company is now run by his wife, Karen Mattacotti. Key persons at the facility include Brooke Smith, Office Manager and Ethan Jacoby, Assistant Plant Manager and EHS Compliance Manager and Chris the Plant Manager of Operations.

We plan to have a response to each of you with a work plan in the next two weeks. We appreciate your consideration as we work through resolution of the insurance coverage issues for funding the remaining remedial activities. We hope to proceed with implementation of the proposed remedial activities promptly upon submittal of the remedial work plan.

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
