On February 4, 1991, the Southern District Close Out Committee held a review session. I presented a brief summary of the naptha spill investigative results to the Committee. Following review and discussion, the Committee agreed that the site no longer poses a significant threat to the environment and can therefore be closed out. If, in the future, further evidence suggests that a more serious problem exists, the Department reserves the right to require additional information and action for this site.

While we are closing out the naptha spill case, you should be aware that we consider the volatile organic compound contamination investigation open and ongoing.
