



Adequate amounts and quality of clay exists at one of the two locations identified; adequate quantities of clay may be available at the second area as well. The availability of clay at the second location will be confirmed in the next several weeks.
- ♦ A surveyor was contracted to complete a survey of the landfill. The final survey presents topography using one foot contour intervals so areas of settling which may have developed since the last survey in 1991 can be easily noted. Capping material quantities will be calculated using the new survey information to ensure appropriate cap thickness and drainage for the planned cap. The survey was complete June 29, 1995.
- ♦ On Monday, June 19, 1995, Hydro-Search completed an extensive series of hand auger borings on the landfill cap to better define areas suspected of having less than 2 feet of clay. Based on information collected during the Remedial Investigation, areas near LC-2, along Highway NN and along the north and west edges of the landfill were identified as having less than 2 feet of clay. The precise extent of areas with less than two feet of clay is critical to estimating the amount of clay required for the new cap. Hand auger borings revealed that a much smaller area of the cap than originally estimated requires additional clay.
