Hi Jeff,

Couple of things that have come up recently for Ripon FF-NN.

- 1. The EPA requested updates from the DNR with greater frequency. We are making progress on most things she wants completed.
 - a. Ordinance change the Town of Ripon removed the non-metallic mining setback exemption that was specific to this landfill. In other words; no mining can occur within 1200 feet of the landfill.
 - b. I'm working on a CO notification that is approved by several layers of management. This mirrors the ICs set in place in 1996. When we get closer to the submittal date, you'll get a chance to read it before it's issued, in case you see something that we should discuss prior to sending it out.
- 2. Off-site notifications
 - a. We are obviously going to notify both mines of the ordinance change and of their COs. There will also have to be ROW notifications. We will handle all those.
 - b. We are going to send a letter to local residents with some general points about where to find information about the landfill, drinking water restrictions and the COs that apply to their properties.
- 3. Requests
 - a. I think we've discussed this previously, so I'm just making sure that you guys are working on new plume maps.
 - b. Also do you have handy which private wells have been retrofitted with monitoring wells? I see that there are several private wells in the network; I'm not sure if those are discrete, re-constructed monitoring wells, or if we are monitoring the private well as is.
 - c. The EPA sees the same thing I do, in the property SW of the landfill; the owner of the other landfill. Probably need to work on sampling his well. The plume certainly is onto his property. How far is the current mystery.

I have a call with EPA later this morning to update progress. If you have an estimate to the next quarterly report submittal, that would be great. Last thing; are you getting the notice about the semi-annual report? We made a bunch of changes to contacts (yours included) so it's possible that notification went to your old email.

If you have anything for me, let me know.
