The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources is requiring that Hein-Werner complete additional work with regard to the former Hein-Werner property located at 1005 Perkins Avenue, Waukesha, Wisconsin.

Pursuant to Condition 5 of the referenced access agreement, Hein-Werner is required to give Mallory Improvements a three (3) business day notice of work.

Please be advised that Key Engineering will be on-site on Friday, July 26, 2002 for the purpose of collecting shallow soil sampling in specific areas agreed to by the Department. The samples will be analyzed to determine if lead concentrations exceed Wisconsin Administrative Code NR 720.11, Table 2, Industrial Contact Level.
