SUBJECT: Ripon Wells #6, #9 (Phantom)

Per the discussion at the June 18, 2019, Closure Committee meeting, this memo is to document the joint decision of the Project Manager (Neste) and the Closure Committee.

Chlorinated Volatile Organic Compounds (CVOCs) have been detected in Ripon municipal wells #6 and #9 dating back to the 1990s. Contaminant levels in well #9 continue to exceed the Enforcement Standard (ES), as of the R&R Program state lead project completion in 2012. Both wells are currently equipped with treatment systems. Despite extensive investigation and a search for an RP by two DNR Professional Geologists (Liz Victor and Christine Lilek), no responsible party has been identified.
