On May 15, 2019, the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) received the 2019 Groundwater Monitoring Report dated May 13, 2019. A review fee was also included with the submittal. The submittal was presented to the Northeast Region Peer Review Committee on June 12,2019 and this letter documents the recommendations made during that meeting.

Based on this review the DNR does not consider natural attenuation groundwater monitoring to be a approvable remedial alternative at this time. You are directed to prepare and submit a Wis. Adm. Code § NR 722.13 Remedial Action Options Report (RAOR) for remediation of chromium in soil and groundwater in the former plating line source area. The post-remedial groundwater monitoring plans should include at a minimum, semi-annual groundwater sampling of wells exhibiting exceedences of the Wis. Adm. Code § NR140 Enforcement Standard and annual monitoring of wells being used for plume delineation. Quarterly sampling of select wells is preferred for the first post remedial year of groundwater monitoring. This RAOR should be submitted by October 31, 2019.
