DNR has reviewed the vapor sampling updates you provided for the former Classic Cleaners redevelopment project.

DNR agrees that additional sub-slab sampling is not required and that active depressurization is not needed.

DNR will require inspections of the passive system and submittal of the inspection log on an annual basis. I

If your client would like to see if the inspection/reporting requirement can be removed, then you would need to do an additional round of sub-slab sampling during the heating season paired with some indoor air sampling (including stairwells and elevator shafts). If those results show no vapor intrusion risk, then the requirement to mitigate vapor and do the inspections/reporting could be removed.
