Subject: Oil Spill

At 12:00 noon today, Commander Merdock of the U.S. Coast Guard called and reported to Hazel that there was a "small oil spill from a boat slip at Marinette Marine."

I called the Coast Guard at 12:40 p.m. and requested further information regarding the oil spill. They reported that John Booker from the company had called them at 11:45 a.m. today stating that a substance called No-Corrood (approximately three gallons) had spilled in the river. They further stated that the spill left a sheen on the water measuring about 20' by 50'.

At 12:50 p.m., I called Tom Roberts at the district office and reported the spill to him. No one on the Marinette Area spill team was in the office at the time. As Andy Krakow, a member of the spill team, indicated office for Wednesday, I called the Ranger Station at Wausaukee and Betty reported she had not seen him all day. I also called his home and received no answer. I called the Oconto Falls Ranger Station and learned that you as well as other employees at the Marinette office were on the Machickanee Flowage.

Tom Roberts called and stated he had gotten in touch with the Coast Guard who in turn called Marinette Marine. The company reported to the Coast Guard that the spill had been cleaned up. He said the substance is a petroleum product.

Tom suggested that you have someone check on it tomorrow to see if the cleanup had taken place and for further details on the spill. He asked that he be sent a report.

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
