SUBJECT: Closure Committee Meeting, May 4, 2004

The Northern Region Closure Committee met on May 4, 2004 at the Rhinelander Service Center. Present were Janet Kazda, Chuck Fitzgerald, Chuck Weister, Bill Schultz, Chris Saari, Phil Richard, John Sager and John Robinson. Jim Hosch attended by phone.

## The Committee discussed the following issues:

Jim recommended closure of the Osceola Creek Sediments file (BRRTS # 02-49-391582), and the Committee agreed to close it. No closure letter will be written, as no RP letter was ever issued.

Phil presented information about the MPM case (BRRTS # 02-49-115395). The Committee denied closure of this case, as Natural Attenuation has not been documented. ASR, NAD.

John Sager summarized the **Former Raith Logging file (BRRTS # 03-34-0001281)**, where there are still increasing and/or unstable trends in some wells. The case was **denied** closure at this time. ASR, NAD, SI-DE, MIM (property boundaries).

John Sager asked the Committee for advice on the Tomahawk Tissue Landfill. He will make up a package with his recommendation to transfer it back to Solid Waste for Long Term Monitoring. We do not close the site, but the Committee will review it for consistency.

Phil asked the Committee for advice on the Osceola Liquor. There was a discussion of future closure options, but no decision was made.

Bill presented the **Northshore Bar (BRRTS # 03-55-107983)** for discussion. Some of the drinking water wells were impacted and replaced at this campground and bar. Some of the monitoring wells do not show a decreasing trend. The case was **denied** closure. NAD, ASR.

Chris summed up the **Midland Services file (BRRTS # 02-04-000090)**, where there was an 11,000 gallon spill when a truck turned over. The case was **closed under NR708.09**, No Further Action. No letter will be written.

Chris provided information on the **Yukon Inn (BRRTS # 03-26-203993).** The Committee agreed to **close** the case, contingent on Monitoring Well abandonment and Groundwater GIS Registry.

Chuck summarized **Custom Landscaping (BRRTS # 02-64-374191),** where there is an increasing trend in some monitoring wells. The case was **denied** closure. NAD, ASR, SI-DE.
