Bob,

It was nice talking with you today. As discussed, the RP (Newell Rubbermaid) for the Mirro#20 site in Chilton submitted a exemption request for groundwater contaminated with 1,2-DCA which they believe is migrating onto the Mirro #20 property from Chilton Metal Products (Worthington Industries). The DNR wanted to make Chilton Metal Products aware of this request prior to the DNR making a

determination on the exemption request. Please let me know how long you and your client will need to determine if they wish to provide analysis or additional information refuting the argument that the 1,2-DCA in groundwater is migrating from Chilton Metal Products site.
