Soil and groundwater at the above-referenced site were not analyzed for polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) because there is no indication that the site was used to produce materials containing PFAS compounds or that any materials containing PFAS were used on the site. The site was historically used as a petroleum bulk storage and transfer facility beginning in the early 1900's, followed by excavating, hauling and landscaping company.
