Hi Trent,

The DNR has reviewed the document *Work Plan for Additional Sampling and Assessment for Per- and Polyflouroalkyl Substances (PFAS)*, dated June 3, 2020, for the Excel Inc. site (BRRTS 02-46—448965). The proposed work includes the collection of one groundwater sample from a well located within the source area, a former dry-cleaning business. You may proceed with the proposed investigation. DNR comments regarding the proposed investigation are provided below.

- Consider collecting an additional PFAS groundwater sample from a monitoring well located downgradient of TW-4.
- As you indicated in an email, the groundwater sample will be analyzed using Environmental Protection Agency Method 537-Modified, which includes the State of Wisconsin 36-compound list.
- The responsible party shall report the sampling results to the DNR within 10 days of receipt, per Wis. Admin. Code § NR 716.14.
- The DNR does not have any established guidance regarding proper disposal of PFAS-contaminated investigation derived waste (IDW). Friess Environmental Consulting, LLC should develop a procedure to address IDW.
- Site investigation is an iterative process. The results of the proposed sampling may indicate that further assessment is needed to define the degree and extent of contamination in all affected media. Additionally, as knowledge surrounding PFAS continues to grow, further investigation may be necessary to define the degree and extent of different compounds.
