Hi Wayne,

The first round of vapor sampling looks really good at the new vapor ports, and a second round in February/March sounds good. Quick reminder to include VP-6 and VP-7, at a minimum, in with VP-8 and VP-9 for subsequent sampling rounds.

PZ-104 and Sump D look like they've had a jump in PCE that should be continued to be monitored, at a minimum, but I recommend monitoring the wells with increases in daughter products as well.

I will need to present the PFAS results to a statewide committee, but the most recent round looks good. I'll get back to you once I have a for sure answer that the PFAS investigation is complete.
