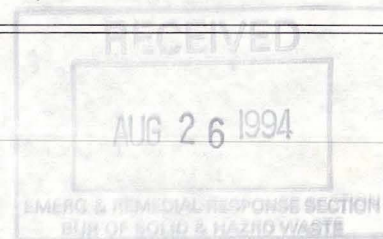

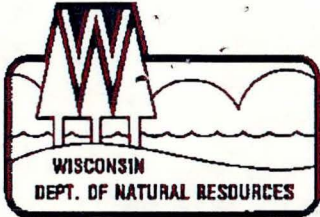

Dear Mr. White:

As you are aware, a release of waste oil and other unknown materials has occurred from tanks on your property. You were asked to respond and take emergency action to contain and cleanup the release on August 22nd. You indicated your inability to respond to Conservation Warden Lance Burns.

The Department initiated emergency action to contain the spilled material on August 22nd, 1994. Our contractor has been on site to complete containment and initial cleanup to prevent further releases to the environment. The site has been secured and locked. A key for the gate is enclosed with this letter upon your request.

Please note that the site has been secured and the gate should continue to be locked to prevent unauthorized access to the site. We will expect that any activities you take at the site will not cause any additional releases nor impede the containment of the current release(s) that have occurred. You may be responsible for further releases occurring from the site.

It is obvious that this site is contaminated and cleanup will be necessary. A full cleanup of the site can only be conducted after a thorough investigation is completed. Cleanup at this site may take an extended period of time! It is our intention to seek assistance from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) for a removal action at this site. This may commence in the near future to eliminate the potential for further releases.


When State Funds are utilized to take action when a responsible party is unwilling or unable, the State attempts a "Cost



Recovery" action to be reimbursed for necessary costs. Any action by USEPA may also be subject to cost recovery by that agency.

Narrative

On 08-18-94 at approximately 3:30pm, David A. White, 2361 Eastman Rd, Apt #1, Green Bay Wi 54302, contacted Warden Lance P. Burns on his mobile phone. Messages had been left to contact the Warden in reference to a large spill on White's property at 1910 20th St., Two Rivers.

Warden Burns informed Mr. White that there was a large spill of waste oil on his property in Two Rivers. The Warden told Mr. White the spill was in excess of 100 gallons and that containment and initial clean-up would have to be started immediately. Mr. White told Warden Burns he didn't have any money to hire someone to do the clean-up and asked if the State could hire some one.

Mr. White was told he would still be responsible for the cost of clean-up and he said he understood this.

Warden Burns asked Mr. White if he had been at the site and White said he had not.
