

EnviroForensics, LLC (EnviroForensics) is providing this Hazardous Waste Exemption Request on behalf of the Portage Cleaners located at 104 East Washington Street in Portage, Wisconsin. EnviroForensics is requesting Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) approval to dispose soil impacted with tetrachloroethene (PCE) and trichloroethene (TCE) that will be generated during remedial activities in a Subtitle D landfill. The source of the impacts is related to the historic dry cleaning operations; therefore, the soil may contain a listed waste per NR 600.

The WDNR's health based direct contact Residual Contaminant Levels (RCLs) for PCE and TCE in soil are 153 mg/kg and 8.8 mg/kg, respectively. As outlined in the attached **Table 1**, the concentrations of PCE and TCE detected within the area proposed for excavation are below the referenced RCLs. The attached **Figure 1** depicts the location of the borings relative to the excavation. Therefore, EnviroForensics requests a Hazardous Waste exemption, permitting the disposal of soil from the Site impacted by PCE and TCE from the Site within a Subtitle D landfill.

This hazardous waste exemption request is being submitted as a supplement to the Site Investigation Update and Interim Remedial Action Plan dated June 5, 2018 in which a technical review fee was included.
