SPIII OCCURED WHILE COOP EMPLOYEE WAS FILLING TANK. THE TANK VENT PIPE WAS BLOCKED CAUSING THE END OF THE TANK TO BLOW OUT. APPROX 104 GALLONS WAS SPILLED ONTO THE BASEMENT DIRT FLOOR OF THE BENGTON RESIDENCE. APPROXIMATELY 95 GALLONS WAS RECOVERED DURING THE INITIAL CLEANUP USING A PUMP AND FLOOR DRY. 9/19/91 RON ANDERSON OF METCO, HILLS BORO 608-782-8889 CALLED WILSON AND INDICATED THAT ADDITIONAL EXCAVATION WOULD BE DONE ON 9/21/91. HE WILL SUPERVISE REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL AND COLLECT THE NECESSARY SAMPLES TO DOCUMENT A CLEAN CLOSURE. A FINAL REPORT WILL BE SUBMITTED TO THE DISTRICT HQ.

At 8:15 am on August 20, 1991 I received a call from Tom Jodarski, Conservation Warden Juneau County. Tom reported that he had been contacted by Mr. Bengtson regarding a release of fuel oil from an exploded tank in his basement.

On August 10, 1991 Hillsboro Farmers Coop put 104 gallons of fuel oil into Mr. Bengtson's tank, located in his basement. At this time the tank exploded. They pumped up what they could from the floor of the basement but it is a dirt floor and some of the fuel oil soaked into the floor. Mr. Bengtson's well is approximately 40 feet from the spill location and is only 40 feet deep.
