FALSTAD DROVE UP TO PUMP WHERE IT APPEARED SPILL OCCURRED. 2 MEN STOOD THERE WITH PAT SULLIVAN TELLING OTHER MAN TO DIG IT UP. HE ALSO STATED "I DON'T WANT ANYONE TO KNOW ABOUT IT INCLUDING THE GUYS IN THE SHOP" ALSO STATED TAKE IT CENTRAL OFFICE COORDINATOR (SEE PAGE 2)

TO STEVE'S FARM " AND YOU MAY HAVE " TO MIX IT " AFTER THE DRIVER LEFT I IDENTIFIED MYSELF AS I WAS WEARING CAMOUFLAGE. SULLIVAN APPEARED SURPRISED! I INFORMED HIM OF ACTION HE MUST TAKE TO CORRECTLY TAKE CARE OF SPILL INCLUDING TAKING TO TORK (AS OPPOSED TO STEVE'S FIELD) AND THAT IT MAY BE IN BEST INTEREST TO HIRE A CONSULTANT.
