Please accept this document as the final report detailing the emergency response and remedial actions taken for the diesel fuel release that occurred on 2/25/2023, at the above referenced location.

#### **INCIDENT BACKGROUND:**

On February 25, 2023, at approximately 12:30 a.m. CST, at the above-referenced Travel Centers of America (TA) location, a tractor-trailer over filled their saddle tank. As a result, approximately 10 gallons of diesel fuel released to the snow covered asphalt surface.

#### **EMERGENCY RESPONSE:**

On February 25, 2023, at approximately 12:46 a.m. CST, a representative from TA retained Cura Emergency Services (CES) to manage the environmental remediation of the site on their behalf. Based on the available information, the CES incident manager dispatched a crew from WRR Environmental Services to assess and remediate the site as necessary.

### **REGULATORY NOTIFICATION:**

Pursuant to Wisconsin state regulations, petroleum related releases in excess of five (5) gallons are considered reportable. This release was estimated to be approximately 10 gallons; therefore, regulatory notification was necessary.

On February 25, 2023, at approximately 1:47 p.m. CST, the CES incident manager verbally reported the release to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources on behalf of TA. The duty-officer issued confirmation number 18738 to the release.

# **REMEDIAL ACTIONS:**

On February 25, 2023, at approximately 3:45 a.m. CST, a crew from WRR arrived onsite. Following a site assessment, crews noted approximately 10 gallons of diesel fuel released to the snow covered asphalt. WRR personnel deployed granular absorbents to the impacted surface and swept them in with hand tools. All diesel fuel impacted material was collected and containerized into seven (7) 55-gallon drums for transport and disposal. WRR personnel noted no further actions required onsite and demobilized.

#### **WASTE DISPOSAL:**

On March 1, 2023, seven (7) 55-gallon drums of diesel fuel-impacted material was transported to, and consolidated with non-hazardous waste at WRR Environmental Services Co., Inc. in Eau Claire, WI (see attached disposal documentation).

#### **CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATIONS:**

Following the corrective actions, no visual or olfactory evidence of diesel fuel were observed at the site. Based on these results, it appears that the corrective actions were successful and no further action should be required. CES recommends that the incident be closed.




