Hi Rob,

I was a little delayed in taking a look at the SIWP, but it looks like a great first phase to additional groundwater and soil delineation. I did want to comment that groundwater flow direction here can be difficult to gauge, with other closed sites in the area documenting radial flow. I recommend installing monitoring wells in the other direction(s) as well, specifically to the south/southwest. I understand this may not be able to be accomplished during this phase of work, but it would be worthwhile to try to knock this out during the same mobilization.

The real-time, in the field analysis of groundwater to direct the placement of permanent monitoring wells is a great idea for this site. It could be very worthwhile in determining flow direction, and it will be interesting to see where monitoring wells are installed.

Also, I'm unsure if you are aware, but there was a [Phase II](#) performed at 1324 S Webster in 2019, with quite a few soil borings and temporary monitoring wells installed on this property. The General Property activity, Village of Allouez / BRRTS # 07-05-585202, received an off-site liability exemption and can be viewed here: [WDNR EM/RR BOTW \(wi.gov\)](#). These soil and gw sample locations should be added to future SIR submittal(s).
