Soap spill at Gunderson Cleaners

SPILL ACTION:

I advised the fire department to clean up with a shovel and put in drums. I spoke with Mr. Greg Kramer, Technical Director for H. Kohnstamm & Co Inc (800-621-4316) about make-up of the spilled material. He said it was a non-toxic, biodegradable, concentrated synthetic detergent (non-ionic) labled as HK Detergent Oil. It contains no phosphates and has a BOD $_5$ of 128 lbs in 55 gallons. It is low foaming. Mr. Kramer is sending a chemical analysis of the soap.

I spoke to Leo Nowicki, WWTP Supt. and he said they'll treat it but not to dump the entire load at once.

CAUSE OF SPILL:

A Fore Way Express truck without a lift mechanism delivered the drum to Gundersons who did not have an elevated unloading dock. The driver and an employee attempted to unload the drum down a board and it fell to the ground and broke open. The driver signed the billing and left. (a copy of the billing is attached)

NOTIFICATION:

The driver signed the billing and left. A Gunderson employee notified the fire department, who in turn notified us. I spoke with Mr. Don Forcey, Safety Director for Fore Way in Appleton (414)739-9464) about notification. He thoughtwe should be notified only if the material spilled is hazardous and had informed his drivers of that. I told him of the oxygen demand of this product and instructed him to notify us of any spill. Many products not classed as hazardous can still cause environmental damage or create a public nuisance.

CORRECTIVE ACTION:

I advised Mr. Forcey and Mr. Kramer that proper unloading equipment should be used in the future to prevent personal injury to workers, loss of product, and environmental damage. This equipment could be on the delivery trucks or at the delivery site.
