On June 27, 2022, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) received a *Post-Closure Modification Request* (PCM Request), submitted on your behalf by Midwest Environmental Consulting, for the property described above.

A cap maintenance plan was established for this property as part of the August 3, 2005 Certificate of Completion which requires prior DNR approval for modifications made to the capped area. Post-closure modifications at the site included removal and replacement of a portion of the existing barrier cap to install a playground. 88.26 tons of excavated soil was properly disposed of at Republic Services Kestrel Hawk landfill in Racine, Wisconsin.

On July 26, 2022, the DNR provided a notice to proceed with the post-closure modification. On October 26, 2022, the DNR received final documentation of the completed post-closure modification.

Information received with the PCM Request and documentation of completion will be uploaded to the DNR BRRTS database. All requirements in the Certificate of Completion are still in effect. Please continue to conduct annual inspections and maintain the Continuing Obligations Inspection and Maintenance Log included in the site's maintenance plan.
