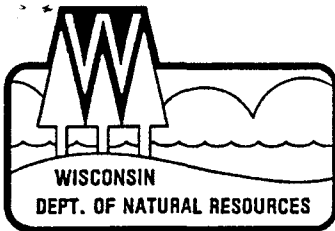

Spill Prevention

Dear Mr. Moore:

I would like to make you aware of the Department's concern over your recent fuel spill. Personnel from your company caused a similar spill in 1994. We believe that this type of spill, i.e., that caused by unattended filling of fuel tanks, is highly preventable.

Wisconsin's Spill Law, in s. 144.76(4), Stats., allows the Department to require, by order, that preventative measures be taken by the responsible party if the Department finds that existing control measures are inadequate to prevent discharges of hazardous substances. Another spill of this nature could prompt this action.

Your company should make every effort to ensure that this does not recur. As you know, even small spills can be time-consuming and expensive.
