Dear Mr. Luedtke:

In a letter dated March 28, 2008, the Department advised you that additional groundwater investigation was required at the former Cermatics, Inc. property in Mequon. A minimum of two additional groundwater monitoring wells are needed on the adjacent property – one northeast of MW-2 and one south/southeast of MW-4 and four rounds of quarterly groundwater monitoring are required. Although there had previously been a monitoring well offsite south of MW-4 which we had hoped you could use for this investigation, this well has been abandoned. It is my understanding that one round of monitoring from the current wells was conducted in August. The Department is requiring the two additional wells to be installed so that they can be sampled during the next monitoring event that should be scheduled for mid-November.

Please ask your consultant to submit in writing a brief workplan for installation of the wells and installation and sampling schedule. The workplan must be submitted for approval prior to the next scheduled monitoring event. The Department will, upon request, consider granting a variance to NR 141 Wis. Adm. Code to allow small diameter wells if the well construction and sampling methods are acceptable.

If you fail to install and sample offsite wells as requested, the Department will consider you to be out of compliance with the Order for Default Judgement. Additionally, by postponing installation and sampling of additional wells you may end up increasing the overall number of sampling events you need to meet closure requirements.
